Mike Chaney recently retired from Procter & Gamble after 38 years of service. During the last decade, he was Vice President Product Supply for Global Grooming category which represents about 12-15% of the P&G company. The product supply function includes manufacturing, procurement, engineering, quality assurance, and supply chain design and management. During his tenure with Procter & Gamble, Mike held a variety of leadership positions across the company's divisions, brands, and regions.
